1 Predictable Patterns

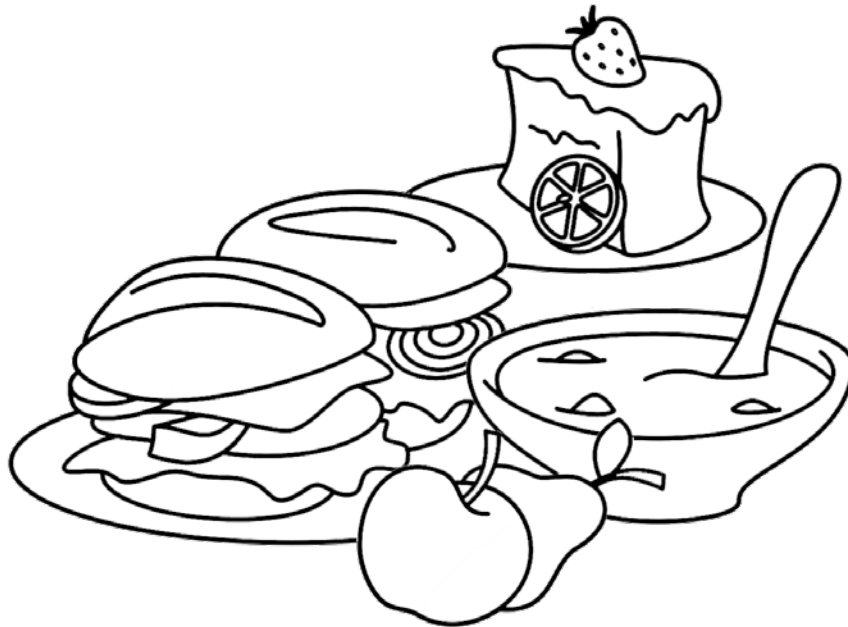
