General Access

Requirements

- Internet access.
- Our website, <u>calicospanish.com</u> should be whitelisted and accessible.
- Audio capabilities; preferably speakers, so that students can watch the online videos.
- The capability to display video available to all learners. We use **Vimeo** for displaying videos. Vimeo must be accessible in the school network firewalls or other security systems or software that may prevent students from viewing embedded Vimeo content.

(If you need to whitelist the specific video URLs in your filter, contact us.)

- Be able to download and read PDF files.
- We use **H5P** to create and display games. See <u>this online thread</u> for specific requirements. Note that SMART and Chromebook touch technology do not work with H5P (but the games may be played with a mouse).

Notes

- We limit the number of failed login attempts; a user is locked out for 2 hours after 10 failed login attempts over a period of 2 hours.
- The default number of active sessions is 2 per user. If teachers, for any reason, require access via more than 2 devices at a time), they should contact support@calicospanish.com to request an increase in this number.

School-to-Home Video Access

- Vimeo should not be blocked by district or parental control software, and
- If parents use Vimeo parental control, they should make sure their children can view videos. You can refer to <u>this video</u> for parental control settings.
